

BOARD OF EDUCATION SELF-EVALUATION

The Swallow School District Board of Education believes that evaluation is essential to the continual improvement and success of a school district. Therefore, the Board of Education shall, on an annual basis, plan and conduct an evaluation of its functioning as the policy making and governance body of the district.

The evaluation plan shall be developed by the Board of Education with the assistance of the Superintendent. This evaluation may be based on a broad realm of relationships and activities, or may be focused on a particular activity or area, as selected by the Board. Such evaluation shall be carried out either in conjunction with the October assessment of the Superintendent, or can be done independent of this assessment if completed by the end of November.
