**SWALLOW SCHOOL DISTRICT
BOARD OF EDUCATION POLICY**

SCHOOL BOARD: CONFLICT OF INTEREST

Members of the Board of Education, or their dependents, shall not have a private pecuniary interest, direct or indirect, in any contract with the School District. They shall not sell anything or provide service to the District that exceeds \$15,000 in any year.

Members of the Board of Education shall not use their public position or office to obtain financial gain or anything of substantial value for the private benefit of themselves or their immediate family, or for an organization with which they are associated.

No person may offer to give to a member of the Board of Education, directly or indirectly, and no member may solicit or accept from any person, directly or indirectly, anything of value if it could reasonably be expected to influence the member’s vote, official actions or judgement, or could reasonably be considered as a reward for any official action or inaction on the part of the member.

A member of the Board of Education shall not take any official action substantially affecting a matter in which the member, an immediate family member, or an organization with which the Board member is associated has a substantial financial interest.
