BOARD OF EDUCATION POLICY

STUDENT EXEMPTION GUIDELINES

Students may be excused, on a limited basis, from particular preplanned classroom instruction or from selected portions of the established curriculum on the basis of personal, religious or ethnic considerations.

All requests for exemptions must be made, in writing, by the student's parent or guardian. The Principal shall be responsible for assessing and acting upon written requests for student exemption from classroom or curriculum activities. It will be the responsibility of the parent or guardian to be familiar with the goals and objectives of the curriculum about which they are concerned. Curriculum guides are available for review upon request. Should an exemption be granted, alternate class work, if feasible, will be assigned.

Although exemptions may be made, students are strongly encouraged to participate fully in classroom and curriculum activities. The curriculum in the Swallow School District is designed to provide students with a well-rounded education. Therefore, it is important for students to be involved in all aspects of the curriculum.
