

Summary of September 15, 2020 Swallow Reopening Task Force Meeting

- Key Messages:
 - At this point Task Force has completed its directive to reopen the school; while members feel that the main work of the Task Force has concluded and thus regular meetings are not needed at this time, members will continue to meet on an as-needed basis moving forward.
 - It is recommended that Swallow launch a new Swallow COVID-19 dashboard on our website and update it at least twice a week with new information.
